**Safety Seminar on
"Benchmarking of Good Safety Practices from Japan Construction Industry"**

- Speaker:** **Mr. YU Pak Kuen, Senior Consultant of Occupational Safety and Health Council**
Mr. Yu is an experienced safety professional of more than 33 years. He had been working as a Factory Inspector in the Labour Department before joining the Occupational Safety and Health Council (OSHC) in 1994. He had engaged in developing and monitoring ISAS safety audit system for Works Bureau and Housing Department construction projects since 1996, and writing "A guide to construction safety management" for Hong Kong construction industry in 2002. He is now responsible for developing enhancement safety management programs which includes work safety behaviour, safety climate and safety culture. The recent product is "International Safe Workplace Program Guide" which is a practical guidance for the participating organizations on the basis of the 7 indicators of World Health Organization (WHO) Safe Community initiative to obtain designation.
- Content:** The Occupational Safety and Health Council (OSHC) had organized a 5-day benchmarking study on construction safety in Japan from 24 to 28 May 2010. The benchmarking study included a series of theoretical, site visits and practical aspects of construction safety. The subjects of this benchmarking visit covered:
1. safety culture improvement programmes - Safe Working Cycle, and KYT in construction industry
 2. safety technology improvement programmes - safe design and structure of tower crane, accident investigation and case studies, and safety management
- The objective of this safety seminar is to share some best practices learned and observed from this benchmarking visit.
- Language:** Cantonese is the primary medium of instruction and English terms are used where applicable.
